Clinton National Airport to Transition to Cashless Parking

LITTLE ROCK, Ark. (Sept. 5, 2024) — Clinton National Airport will transition to cashless parking starting next week. Beginning Monday, September 9, the airport will discontinue staffing its main parking payment booths. Payments will be processed at self-service kiosks that accept credit cards, Google Pay, and Apple Pay.

With 96% of airport parking customers already using credit cards, the change will allow additional employees to assist passengers as needed in the parking lots and terminal.

For those with cash only, an employee will be available to handle payments upon request for the next several months. A kiosk in the ticket lobby will also offer cash-to-credit card conversions.

Airlines and most airport vendors have already phased out cash transactions. The airport stopped staffing its economy and west short-term parking booths in 2020.
